Regulations & qualifications for Entry

- 1. **Entries will be accepted** from any player registered for a club in membership of a league affiliated to Suffolk County T.T.A, or a registered member of a directly affiliated club, or a directly affiliated player, or attends any school under the authority of Suffolk County Council affiliated to Suffolk Schools T.T.A.
- 2. **No entry will be accepted** from or on behalf of any player who is ranked by or who has expressed a preference to be considered by any other county.
- 3. **Age Qualifications** As per entry form.
- 4. Any player found to have played in a league or body not affiliated directly to the ETTA without good reason will not be allowed to enter.
- 5. **Restricted singles** open to any player of either sex qualified under reg1/2 except
 - (1) No entry will be accepted from male players included in the first 10 places in the men's senior ranking list of the STTA
 - (2) No entry will be accepted from any player who the championship committee deem to be of at least equal ability to a player excluded under Reg 4 (1)
- 6. **Dress code -** As per ETTA regulations no outdoor shoes
- 7. **Umpiring** Except during group matches where the umpire will be notified all losing players up to the final will return the scoreboard & ball to the referee's table & be available for umpiring the next scheduled game.
- 8. **Bats** One side must be red & other black as per ETTA/ITTF regulations, rubbers must comply with ITTF regulations for the 2017/2018 season.
- 9. The new regulations for glue and certain pimpled rubber apply here as per ETTA rules this year, no speed glue or pimpled rubber outlawed by the governing body to be used
- 10. Coaching of players & Time outs are allowed as per ETTA & ITTF regulations.
- 11. All entry forms must be accompanied by the correct fees
